1. Purpose

Built Projects are committed to the pursuit and ultimate sustainability of Zero Harm.

2. Strategies

To achieve this, The Managing Director is committed to providing all appropriate resources, necessary tools, and procedures to facilitate the success of this business objective.

- Eliminate known or foreseeable hazards when reasonably practicable.
- Control to a level that is acceptable to all stakeholders any known or foreseeable hazards/risks that cannot be eliminated by using the hierarchy of control.
- Built Projects will:
 - Provide and maintain a safe working environment.
 - Provide and maintain safe plant & structures.
 - Provide and maintain safe systems of work.
 - Ensure safe use, handling and storage of plant, structures, and substances.
 - Ensure provision of all necessary information, training, instruction, or supervision.
- To make sure relevant Built Projects personnel understand their roles for the safe operation of the organisation's activities.
- Plan for the management of reasonably foreseeable emergencies.
- Monitor the effectiveness of the WHS Management System.
- Consult with workers in aspects that affect their health and safety.
- Acknowledge a worker's right to cease unsafe work.
